## Department Reports:

Building Inspector Joseph Colern informed the Town Board that he will have his August building report for the next meeting.

Water Superintendent Eugene Stevenson noted that the fire hydrant on Bullis Road has been repaired. Triton Valley Mobile Home Park has not complied with the backflow plans that were submitted for the deadline date of September, 2013. Eric County Water has given Triton Valley until October 1, 2013 to comply and will monitor their progress. The Town Attorney and Mr. Stevenson will look into the Town doing the backflow installation and billing Trition Valley Mobile Home Park. Also the gas line on Rice Road is completed.
